Biography

Born 1946 on Ellis Island, New York, Denise Regan is an American painter with a career spanning more than five decades. She earned her BFA from Wagner College in 1972 and her MFA from New York University in 1976, studying with Ilya Bolotowsky, Chuck Close, and Paul Pollaro. Her practice moves between still life, landscape, and the figure, translating observation and memory into luminous, color-saturated paintings. Her work has been exhibited in solo and group shows from New York and East Hampton to Chicago, Sun Valley, Santa Monica, Savannah, and Washington, D.C., and is held in corporate, institutional, and private collections worldwide.
